

## Resource Search

Looking for something? Want to find a specific book or a video? Contact information for your preferred interpreting services?

If you are not sure about how to begin searching for resources, begin at the top right of the website and click on the “Search” icon (a magnifying glass icon seen below). It will take you to the “Search Resources” page.



Once you are on the “Search Resources” page, you should be able to see the search engine on the left side to help you with finding relevant resources. For mobile users, the box will be at the top.

Type in a keyword in the Search box and hit return or click the submit icon to begin searching.

This will take you to the “Search Resources” page results for your keyword search.

If you want to filter the results to sort out the results by type of source, use the Type of Source box. For example, if you want to find a list of videos about Black Deaf people, you can type in Black as a search term and select Video as Type of Source. Same goes for the Topic box with topics.

Some examples of things you could search for:

- Children ASL storytime videos
- Deaf community events
- Assistive technology
- Deaf organizations and government agencies that represent the deaf
